Commercial Pilot Scholarship

Scholarship Details

- The scholarship is open to all applicants regardless age or gender who currently holds a Private Pilot Licence.
- Applicants must meet the minimum age criteria to obtain a Commercial Pilot's licence and be of good physical health in order to acquire a Category 1 medical certificate by a Transport Canada Certified Medical Examiner.
- All scholarship monies awarded will be held on account in the recipient's name at the **Windsor Flying Club** and costs for flight training, books, ground school fees, examination and flight test fees and will be deducted from the recipient's account as used and a pre-determined milestones are achieved.
- Scholarship funds are to be used for flight training and classes at the **Windsor Flying Club** and will not be available for lodging, transportation, food or for training at a different flight school or college.
- The amount of the scholarship award is wholly dependant upon funds raised through donations, corporate sponsors and fundraising events that are held throughout the year. The amount allocated to each recipient as well as the number of recipients will be determined by the Windsor Flying Club Board of Directors, the management staff and scholarship committee members.

Application Process

1. Complete the application included in this package. Email the completed application along with a letter explaining your career ambitions, your reason for applying for this scholarship along any other information you feel would provide the selection committee with a better understanding of you, your desire to acquire a Commercial Pilot's Licence and pursue a career in aviation. Since the **Windsor Flying Club** is a not-for-profit entity, it is staffed by only a few paid employees while the remainder, including the Board of Directors are volunteers. Hence, any volunteer experiences and community involvement should be included in the letter. Once the application and letter are complete, email these to: scholarship@windsorflyingclub.com with "**APPLICATION**" in the subject line.
2. Once the applications are reviewed, successful applicants will receive an invitation to meet with members from the Board of Directors, Windsor Flying Club staff, and the scholarship committee for an in-person interview.
3. The selected recipient(s) will be invited to attend the 2019 **Windsor Flying Club** awards banquet where they will receive a certificate for their scholarship.

Selection Criteria

- While it is necessary to have a Private Pilot's Licence, having additional flight training, licences and / or having successfully completed advanced Transport Canada examinations will show the selection committee your aptitude, drive, ability and desire to complete the program.
- Proven dedication and pursuit of higher education and / or skills training.
- Volunteer experience at a variety of groups and institutions in the community is a definite asset.
- Successful interview with the selection committee.

Applications for the 2019 Scholarship must be received by: **October 31, 2019**.
